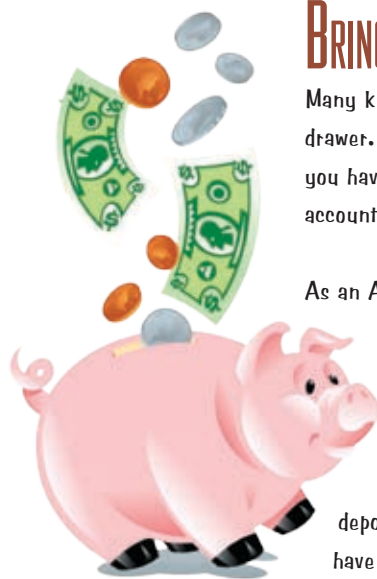


BRING YOUR PIGGY BANK TO THE CREDIT UNION!

4 NEW PENNIES FOR 2009!

Four new penny designs are scheduled to start circulating in 2009. The designs commemorate the bicentennial of President Abraham Lincoln's birth and the 100th anniversary of the Lincoln penny. The first new penny will be put into circulation on February 12, 2009, and each new design will be presented in three-month intervals throughout the year.

PENNY FACTS

- At the U.S. Mint, workers produce 30 million pennies per day. (That's about 1,040 pennies per second!)
- Most pennies circulate for approximately 30 years. Right now, experts estimate that nearly 150 billion pennies are in circulation.
- The penny was adopted as legal tender in 1864. Its design included an Indian Head on the front and an Olive Wreath on the back.
